#### **VCHA Board Meeting Minutes**

Minutes of the April 2018 Board Meeting

The April board meeting was held Wednesday, April 4, 2018 at Stacey Powers' residence in Petaluma, Ca.

President, Stacey Powers called the meeting to order at 6:25pm

Board members in attendance were: Stacey Powers, April Alianza, LyndaBell Jacobsen, Steve Litzky, Cheryl Jensen, Gary Long and Carla Hagge.

Absent and excused was Heidi Thompson; Lori Lindsey able to attend, unknow reason.

Guests in attendance were: Cassie Alianza & Bobby Giannecchini.

**Consent Calendar:** Stacey inquired if everyone had reviewed the March Meeting Minutes. Being no changes to the minutes, Cheryl motioned to accept the minutes, April seconded.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> LyndaBell reported

Income for March: \$160.00 (Membership Dues) Expenses for March: \$14.00 (show phone line)

\$375 (Renewal for Faster Cut)

Resulting in an operating loss of -\$229.00

Carla motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report, Cheryl seconded. April approved to pay the bills, Carla seconded.

LyndaBell requested Stacey and April update signatures on file at Bank of the West, due to officer changes.

Stacey reported the club received a \$500 platinum sponsorship from Redwood Empire Cutting Horse Association. LyndaBell reported an additional \$500 platinum sponsorship from Wine Country Ranch Supply.

<u>Unfinished Business:</u> Stacey inquired as to finalizing the 2017 Annual Meeting Minutes. April reported she would have them finished by the end of the week.

Media Channels: Stacey asked if April & Lori had a chance to meet regarding the blog. April reported not yet.

**Insurance:** Steve reported he is still trying to contact Ron Zanetti; but they have yet to connect; in order to get insurance quotes for all our current coverages. Stacey volunteered to call and scan a copy of our insurance policies to Ron.

**Sponsorship**: Board discussed 2018 Sponsorship List. It was clarified the sponsors levels which include banners, will need to provide their own banners; the board member who secured said sponsorship(s) will be responsible for obtaining and returning the banner, at year-end.

<u>Media & Newsletter</u>: April reported she posted PRDC's Tack Clean & Swap Meet on our website and FB. She also reported the interactive calendar is now on our website; but it isn't as interactive as she had hoped, but it was the free version. She suggested we all log on and take a look and let her know if we have any comments or suggestions.

April provided and disbursed a list of 2016 members that did not rejoined in 2017: Stacey divided up the pages between board members. Board members will contact those past members to determine reason for not rejoining.

**Show Committee:** LyndaBell reported she is getting ready for the first show and will be available for the & Playday at the Wagon Wheel Ranch. She renewed our Faster Cut software, and everything is up to date.

Stacey asked Gary along with balance of the board, their thoughts of offering trainers two free re-run practices at each show, and waiving the trainer's membership, by bringing 2 new clients/riders that are showing and provide help with turn back-show help throughout the day.

Gary suggestion to get more trainers to bring amateur riders to our shows, offer a 10% discount off their entry fee and add that dollar amount to the jack pot.

LyndaBell made a motion to accept Stacey's recommendation, Cheryl seconded. Gary and Stacey will take the lead to reach out to the trainers with the new membership promotion.

**Judges:** Nothing new to report.

<u>Cattle</u>: There was a lengthy discussion regarding a possible new cattle source, which has Hawaiian cattle available. The board discussed the positives and possible negatives. PRDC was a concern as to their use of cattle, and the willingness of the new cattle source. A motion was made to move forward with the Hawaiian Cattle and secure a contract.

**Show Footing/Ground:** Stacey reported Eric can only commit to being grounds person for the May Show; plus, he can only stay until 2pm. Gary reminded the board, that Bob G. had committed to Friday nights arenaprep. Gary stated Alan Mahoney has offered to work the ground on show days. Stacey to follow-up with Alan

Stacey recommended we set a date to clean up the show trailer before May show; vacuum, clean and check banners. May 15<sup>th</sup> at 4:30 was agreed upon.

Stacey mentioned PRDC will be having a "work- party day" on Sunday, May 6th. April said she will put that in the newsletter and post on Vintage's FB page.

**Practices & Playdays:** Stacey reported in Heidi's absence; about the April 15<sup>th</sup> Fresh Cattle Clinic at the Wagon Wheel Ranch is full. The cost will be \$100 for fresh cattle, \$50 for re-run cattle and \$140 for all day. We will need help with lunch. Kit offered to help with receiving and feeding of the cattle. Steve offered to help with turn back. A recommendation was made, we cover the cleaning of the porta-potty which costs \$70, and Daniel for working the ground. Cheryl motioned to approve, April seconded. The board approved both.

**Awards Committee:** Carla had nothing new to report.

**New Business:** - Redwood Empire Cutting Horse Association, will be holding their last show in Corning on April 20 – 22: RECHA will be hosting a "Welcome-Hospitality" party and needs help with wine, food donations, and people to set-up and pour. Gary said he and Lori will take care of all that is necessary to represent Vintage.

Local covered arenas were discussed for future clinics and playdays in winter months.
